WKAN Bill Yohnka Radio Show Moves to Farmers Market

Kankakee, IL – Bill Yohnka’s Saturday afternoon radio show on WKAN AM 1320 that normally airs 1-3pm is now a live remote broadcasting from the **Kankakee Downtown Farmers’ Market starting Saturday, June 21 from 8-10am**. Yohnka will interview vendors and customers from the Farmers’ Market and feature local musical talent.
